

Solon Cemetery Index

- #1: Hunt, Phillip T. – Pioneer 1845-1930 Uncle Phill (A footstone also)
- #2: Smith, Allen M. – May 10, 1914-Dec. 20, 1952
- #3: Smith, Pearl – Oct. 6, 1886-June 29, 1971
- #4: William J. Smith – Sep. 16, 1886-July 19, 1975
- #5: Marker reads “Our babies-Watson and Allen” – Grave area is outlined with bricks set on the edge into the ground, perhaps containing several graves, near brick shed.
- #6: Smith, Mable B. – 1882-1958
- #7: Smith, Fred A. – 1884-1958
- #8: Smith, Hattie – dau. of G.S. Smith Sep. 26, 1911-Nov. 11, 1911
- #9: Gilstrap, Nancy J. – Died Jan. 9, 1890 (or 1896?) 74yr. 9 mo. 12da.
- #10: Husband-James Monroe Smith – 1872-1943 “Rest in Peace”
- #11: ‘Mother’ (marker with ‘Mother’ only inscription)
- #12: Smith, Rev. Thomas – Born at Combosnathen, Lanarkshire, Scotland 6 Sep. 1812
Died 16 Nov. 1 o’clock – 38 minutes, 1879 Aged 67yr. 2mo. & 8 da. “Oh to Grace how great a debtor. Daily I’m constrained to be sin hath bound me with fetters. But thy death hath made me free.”
- #13: Hickok, Freddie S. – 1879-1880
- *Note: Zones #14 through 29 inclusive in a row near west boundary fence, east of north-south county road.**
- #14: Hendricks, Mellie NH. – dau. of D & H.M. Hendricks, Died Aug. 22, 1873, 8mo. 27da. “Beautiful & lovely she was, but given a fair bud to earth, to blossom in heaven.” (Footstone reads ‘M.N.H.’)
- #15: ‘C.N’ (Marker next to Clara)
- #16: Hendricks, Clara C. – dau. of D & H.M. Hendricks, Died Feb 12, 1889, 7yr. 5mo. 28da.
- #17: Goffman, J.A.S. – Died 26, 1873 36yr. 2mo. 17da. (Footstone J.G.)

#18 & #19: E.A.E. – Son to T.J. & C. Smith Died Nov. 5, 1874 9mo. 14da. 7hs.

#20: Smith, Thomas J. – 1847-1923/Smith, Catharine Hendricks – His wife 1847-1916
(Combination Headstone)

#21: Clark, Thomas – son of H and M Clark Died Apr. 26, 1879 4da. “Sleep on sweet baby and take thy rest. God called thee home. He thought it best.”

#22: King, Elizabeth M. – dau. of G.E. & M.J. King Died Feb. 23, 1889 1da.

#23: ‘K’ (Marker with initial only)

#24: King, Jacob W. – son of G.E.K., “Gone Home” Died July 12, 1878 12yr. 8mo. 9da.

#25: ‘J.W.K’

#26: King, J.H. – son of G.E. King Died Sep. 28, 1870 18mo. 16da.

#27: (Unreadable)

#28: McKibbin, Charles L. – son of S. & H. McKibbin “Gone Home” Died Dec. 16, 1879
12yr. 7mo. 10da. (Footstone: ‘C.L. McK’ – Stolen by vandals in 1989) “The blood of
Jesus Christ His son cleanseth us from all sin.”

#29: Douglass, Elizabeth – Died June 5, 1874 74yr. 1mo. 13da.
